

# **1.0 A Positive Voltage Regulators**

The NCP7800E series consists of 3 pin, fixed output, positive linear voltage regulators, suitable for a wide variety of applications. These regulators are extremely rugged, incorporating internal current limiting, thermal shutdown and safe-area compensation. With adequate heat sinking they can deliver output currents in excess of 1.0 A. Designed as direct replacements for the popular MC7800 family, these products offer enhanced ESD protection.

A common ground is required between the input and the output voltages. The input voltage must remain typically 2.0 V above the output voltage even during the low point on the input ripple voltage.

- \*\*  $C_O$  is not needed for stability; however, it does improve transient response. Values of less than 0.1  $\mu$ F could cause instability.






Figure 2. Simplified Block Diagram




Figure 3. Peak Output Current as a Function of Input/Output Differential Voltage




Figure 5. Ripple Rejection as a Function of Frequency (NCP7805E)




Figure 7. Output Impedance as a Function of Output Voltage




Figure 4. Ripple Rejection as a Function of Output Voltage




Figure 6. Output Voltage as a Function of Junction Temperature (NCP7805E)




Figure 8. Quiescent Current as a Function of Temperature (NCP7805E)


# **APPLICATIONS INFORMATION**

# **Design Considerations**

The NCP7800E Series of fixed voltage regulators are designed with Thermal Overload Protection that shuts down the circuit when subjected to an excessive power overload condition, Internal Short Circuit Protection that limits the maximum current the circuit will pass, and Output Transistor Safe—Area Compensation that reduces the output short circuit current as the voltage across the pass transistor is increased.

In many low current applications, compensation capacitors are not required. However, it is recommended that the regulator input be bypassed with a capacitor if the regulator is connected to the power supply filter with long wire lengths, or if the output load capacitance is large. An

input bypass capacitor should be selected to provide good high–frequency characteristics to insure stable operation under all load conditions. A 0.33  $\mu F$  or larger tantalum, mylar, or other capacitor having low internal impedance at high frequencies should be chosen. The bypass capacitor should be mounted with the shortest possible leads directly across the regulators input terminals. Normally good construction techniques should be used to minimize ground loops and lead resistance drops since the regulator has no external sense lead.




The NCP7800E regulators can also be used as a current source when connected as above. In order to minimize dissipation the NCP7805E is chosen in this application. Resistor R determines the current as follows:

$$I_0 = \frac{5.0 \text{ V}}{R} + I_B$$

 $I_{R} \cong 3.2$  mA over line and load changes.

For example, a 1.0 A current source would require R to be a 5.0  $\Omega$ , 10 W resistor and the output voltage compliance would be the input voltage less 7.0 V.


Figure 9. Current Regulator


The NCP7800E series can be current boosted with a PNP transistor. The MJ2955 provides current to 5.0 A. Resistor R in conjunction with the  $V_{BE}$  of the PNP determines when the pass transistor begins conducting; this circuit is not short circuit proof. Input/output differential voltage minimum is increased by  $V_{BE}$  of the pass transistor.

The addition of an operational amplifier allows adjustment to higher or intermediate values while retaining regulation characteristics. The minimum voltage obtainable with this arrangement is 2.0 V greater than the regulator voltage.

The circuit of Figure 11 can be modified to provide supply protection against short circuits by adding a short circuit sense resistor,  $R_{SC}$ , and an additional PNP transistor. The current sensing PNP must be able to handle the short circuit current of the three-terminal regulator. Therefore, a four-ampere plastic power transistor is specified.

**Figure 12. Short Circuit Protection** 




Figure 13. Worst Case Power Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature (TO-220)

#### **Protection Diode**

The NCP7800E Series has internal low impedance (about 1  $\Omega$ ) diode path that normally does not require protection when used in the typical regulator applications. The path connects between output and input and it can withstand a peak surge current of about 5 A for a reasonable time (several milliseconds). Normal cycling of Vin cannot generate a current surge of this magnitude for too long time since output capacitor discharges from output to input and follows input voltage therefore the magnitude of reverse current is not so high. However, when Vin is shorted or crowbarred to ground and output cap is too large and moreover if higher voltage option is used then the peak of reverse current is much higher than 5 A and lasts more than





Figure 14. Input Output Differential as a Function of Junction Temperature

several milliseconds. In this case a damage may occur to the regulator.

To protect the regulator the external bypass diode connected between output and input is recommended. The protection diode should be rated for sufficient peak current.

# **DEFINITIONS**

**Line Regulation** – The change in output voltage for a change in the input voltage. The measurement is made under conditions of low dissipation or by using pulse techniques such that the average chip temperature is not significantly affected.

**Load Regulation** – The change in output voltage for a change in load current at constant chip temperature.

**Maximum Power Dissipation** – The maximum total device dissipation for which the regulator will operate within specifications.

**Quiescent Current** – That part of the input current that is not delivered to the load.

**Output Noise Voltage** – The rms ac voltage at the output, with constant load and no input ripple, measured over a specified frequency range.

**Long Term Stability** – Output voltage stability under accelerated life test conditions with the maximum rated voltage listed in the devices' electrical characteristics and maximum power dissipation.




